- 5. EOI Proposal will be evaluated on the basis of the following broad criteria.
 - I. The firm should have been in consulting business for at least 10 years and having valid registration of Company.
 - II. Consultant should have valid GST and all other applicable tax registration certificate and copies of the same duly attested must be furnished.
- III. The firms shall be financially sound with an average turnover of more than INR 200 million during the previous five years i.e. 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24, duly supported by a valid audited Balance Sheet in the books of account certified by charted accountant with Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN).
- IV. The firm should have experience of similar/related assignment including in studies of rivers basin that incorporate: flood and sediment modelling and management, inundation mapping, impact forecasting, early warning generation and dissemination systems, GIS/database management, etc.



- V. The firm should have experts with expertise in: Hydrological and Hydraulic Modelling, River Morphology, Decision Support System Development, Institutional Development, Management Support, Training, etc.
- 6. Foreign firms & Joint Venture/Association of Firms.
 - i) Foreign firms shall be considered for shortlisted only when the firm has a representative office in India.
 - ii) In case there is a joint venture, the required information shall be furnished by each party separately along with joint venture agreement.
 - iii) In case of Joint Venture (JV), the proposal of consultant would be evaluated jointly and the empanelment will be in the joint name. However, if a proposal of association is received the particulars of lead firm shall only be evaluated.
 - iv) In case of a joint venture the highest shareholding firm, would be the lead partner and the lead partner would be responsible for the project and would provide 50% of the manpower and at least 25% of manpower from each of the other firms. The manpower engaged by the firm should preferably be on their payroll.
 - v) As far as possible there should not be change in the man power after contract award. In urgent necessity maximum 25% personnel change can be allowed, after prior approval from Water Resources Department, Bihar. Replacement should be done with equivalent capable personnel.
 - vi) Consultant should not have been black listed by any Government Department, Organization, Authority or any Public Sector Undertaking owned by Government during the last six years as on the date of offer submission.
- 7. On the basis of above criteria consultants meeting the requirement should be shortlisted for further consideration.
- 8. Request for Proposal (RFP) shall be invited to the shortlisted consultants to seek their technical and financial proposal.
- 9. The Consultant shall upload the readable scanned copies of all relevant certificates/documents on the e-procurement portal (http://eproc2.bihar.gov.in).
